



2010 NYAA PARENT POLICY

The Nebraska Youth Athletic Association (NYAA) has a history of being the best of the best in providing a positive Sportsmanship Environment for its players, parents, and spectators.

1. Encourage members of both teams.
2. Keep all comments positive.
3. Only players and coaches allowed on the field, no exceptions.
4. Leave the coaching to the coaches. Issues need to be resolved via the Athletic Director.
5. Do not confront coaches before, during or after a game or during practice.
6. Criticizing the officials, coaches and opponents will not be tolerated.
7. Abusive language and cursing will not be tolerated.
8. You are responsible for all family members and friends attending the games.
9. No open alcoholic beverages or tobacco products on fields, parks, gyms or parking areas.
10. Help make this a positive and fun experience for all.
11. Report any violations to a board member or a team parent rep.
Get involved.
12. Be responsible for all NYAA equipment. All equipment will be returned immediately at end of season, if necessary, upon dismissal from team. Failure to do so will result in the cost of equipment, as well as legal and collection costs being assessed to player's parent/guardian.
13. Our program is bigger than any one player, coach or spectator.
14. I understand that my behavior at any NYAA sponsored event will have a negative impact on the NYAA mission.

POLICY ENFORCEMENT

1. Individuals may be given one warning for inappropriate activity.
2. Individuals that continue will be asked to leave the fields, gyms, or parks and the player will be removed from the game until the parent/spectator has left.
3. Other sanctions as deemed necessary by the president or board may be enforced including permanent ban.
